Autumn

Autumn is a season in which the weather gets cooler, and it gets darker earlier. During autumn time, most leaves start to change colour and leaves fall off some trees and they eventually become bare. Autumn starts in September and ends in November.

Animals

During autumn time some animals, such as hedgehogs begin to hibernate to escape the cold and lack of food during winter.

Harvest

In the autumn, farmers harvest vegetables. Farmers harvest crops using machinery or by hand.

Harvest Festival

Harvest is celebrated to give thanks for the crops that the farmers have worked hard to grow.
