Sticky Knowledge – We want you to know...

1. The weather **brightens** and the **temperature** begins to increase during Spring. It starts to get **warmer**.
2. There are more hours of **daylight** and it takes longer to get dark at night.
3. Plants, flowers and trees start to grow again.
4. Animals that hibernate during Winter begin to wake up.
5. Baby animals are born including rabbits, chicks, lambs and calves.

Key Vocabulary

Spring - The brighter season that begins after Winter ends.

Weather - The change of state in the atmosphere such as rain, cloud, thunder, sunshine etc.

Temperature - used to describe how cold or hot something is, including the weather or food.

Blossomed - The appearance of flowers on plants and trees. E.g., The trees have blossomed in pink flowers.

Offspring - A baby animal in relation to their mother.
