Milk and Toast Money

If your child is not having milk and toast but you would still like them to have a morning snack then please send them with a piece of fruit or a healthy snack. Chocolate and crisps are not allowed at morning break. Water is available throughout the day.

Snack money for the children in Swallows (Reception) is £1 per week. This is also payable on a Friday.

This will be a chance to meet your child's new class teacher, discuss how your child is settling in and make the class teacher aware of any particular issues.
